COMMISSIONER UPDATE SYNOPSIS 2/16/2023

REVENUE -

January revenue numbers are up due to new and returning winter events. January collected revenue is \$110,531. We received a TLT transfer of \$83,780 which is not included in my January event revenue report.

We missed the Albany Lions Club gun show that was canceled but scheduled for the first weekend in January. I hope to see this event return for 2024 – all indications are pointing to a return.

We are planning for very a busy spring and summer season. Event bookings are solid up to July where we take a pause for the annual Linn County Fair. Fall and Winter seasons are busier than usual with several new week-long dog show events scheduled.

Conference room use has been on the rise for 2023. We had 8 open days in the month of January I see this trend continuing through 2023.

Winter Rod and Speed Show was held January 20-21. They reported a good year overall with attendance and participation being on par with their 2022 event.

Mid-Winter Square Dance Festival is always a great event attracting many attendees from outside Linn County. In recent years they have had a declining attendance and with Covid canceling years 2020 and 2021 they were not sure they would survive as a group. 2023 numbers were a surprise as they had more registrations this year than in the previous 5. Mid-Winter is happy with our facility and continually complements staff. They are excited to return for 2024.
