Board Summaries for April 18, 2023

R&O 2022-075

This is a Personal Services Contract between Linn County and Albany Partnership for Housing and Community Development to provide increased housing supports, client community tenure and positive rental history for up to 20-25 clients. This contract is a pass thru from funds provided by Oregon Health Authority with a not to exceed amount of \$110,000.00.

R&O 2023-105

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Linn County and Portland State University (PSU). PSU will conduct a coalition assessment for Linn County Alcohol and Drug with grant funds provided to Linn County from Drug Free Communities Grant (DFC). The contract term date is January 1, 2022 to September 29, 2025 with a not to exceed amount of \$27,000.00.

R&O 2023-123

This is a grant agreement between National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) and Linn County. NACCHO is providing a grant of \$10,000.00 to the Health Department to be transferred to the Linn County Sheriff Office to purchase two evacuation kart and medical treatment supplies.

This is a pass thru grant from InterCommunity Health Network (IHNCCO) to provide Community Health Care worker and funds to assist with identifying housing options and their viability, application for rental units and rental assistance to bridge GAPS Student Houselessness.

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement to Mutual Termination of Oregon Health Authority Intergovernmental Agreement #170115. Agreement# 170015 provided FEMA COVID funding. This termination would be effective May 11, 2023.

This is a Contact for Professional Services between Samaritan Health Services and Linn County to delegate Dr. Adam Brady as the Linn County Health Officer. This contract will pay \$180.00 per hour up to 3 hours per week. The contract states Dr. Brady will attend in person the Board of Health meetings on the third Tuesday of every month. The contract is in effect from March 1, 2023 to June 30, 2026.

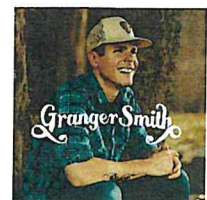
