Board Summaries for October 17, 2023

R&O 2023-125 - This is a Personal Services contract between CHANCE and Linn County to provide Mental Health Peer support services to Mental Health clients. This contract has a not to exceed amount of \$100,000 with an effective date of April 1, 2023, and termination date of June 30, 2024.

R&O 2023-359 - This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Oregon State University and Linn County for OSU. Linn County is providing a grant for an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 for OSU to provide food to individuals experiencing food insecurity.

R&O 2023-364 - This is a Personal Services Contract between Century Farm Equestrian Center and Linn County to teach basic horsemanship and horse care through a 25-week group. The contract has a not to exceed amount of \$60,000 with an effective date of October 1, 2023, and termination date of December 31, 2024. These services are reimbursed by Medicaid.

R&O 2023-374 – This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Oregon Health Authority and Linn County. This Agreement allows Linn County to access the State of Oregon's database system to input Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Screening documentation.

R&O 2023-381 - This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between OHSU and Linn County. This agreement allows Linn County to access OHSU Connect which allows access to Protected Health Information (PHI) in electronic medical records for public health purposes.

R&O 2023-382 - This is Amendment #1 to the Intergovernmental Agreement between Oregon Health Authority and Linn County. This amendment reallocates funds from one category to another category. This reallocation was requested by Linn County.

R&O 2023-383 – This is a Grant Agreement between the State of Oregon, Criminal Justice Commission and Linn County. This agreement is for an amount not to exceed \$315,928 and a termination date of March 31, 2026. This agreement provides funding for the Linn County Adult Drug Court.

R&O 2023-385 - This is Amendment #5 to the Intergovernmental Agreement between OHSU and Linn County. This amendment provides funding for calendar year 2024 for \$29,024.00.

R&O 2023-377 Linn County Coordinated Plan Summary:

In order to receive State and Federal transportation funding, Linn County is required to have a Coordinated Plan on file with ODOT and update this plan every three years. The Coordinated Plan houses information and instructions on how funds may be prioritized in Linn County for transportation projects. It includes a description of Linn County covering: population statistics, demographic information, and available services in Linn County. The document identifies needs and a list of strategies to maintain and improve services.

The Linn County Coordinated Plan has been through an extensive revisions process initially spearheaded by Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments partnering with Nelson Nygaard. The document presented by OCWCOG was then further edited by the Linn County Transportation Advisory Committee.

ODOT requires the Coordinated Plan pass local process including approval/adoption by the governing body. The Linn County Transportation Advisory Committee convened in public meeting on September 28th, 2023 and made recommendation that the Linn County Board of Commissioners approve the 2023 Linn County Coordinated Plan as presented.

Once the Linn County Coordinated Plan is approved by the Board of Commissioners, the updated version will be submitted to ODOT, referenced for future funding, and replace past versions on the Linn County website.

Recommendation:

It is respectfully requested that the Board of Commissioners adopt the 2023 Linn County Coordinated Plan.

R&O 2023-380 STIF Discretionary Funds Summary:

STIF Discretionary Funds are Statewide competitive funds where ODOT selects project proposals submitted from all over Oregon. Many Public Transportation Service Providers possess qualifications that allow them to independently submit application on their own behalf. Senior Citizens of Sweet Home, Inc./Linn Shuttle requires the assistance of a qualifying entity to access these funds which is a standard function of the Linn County Transportation Program.

Linn County worked with Senior Citizens of Sweet Home, Inc. to submit a project proposal for acquisition of a new vehicle. Much of the fleet at Linn Shuttle is nearing the end of its useful life and the program has been soliciting funds from many different resources to lower the average age of their fleet.

ODOT selected the Linn County/Senior Citizens of Sweet Home Inc. project for funding in the 2023-2025 biennium. The STIF Discretionary ODOT Grant Agreement 35593 not to exceed \$140,000.00, was reviewed and BOC approved on 09/26/2023.

Resolution and Order 2023-380 is to establish a sub-recipient contract between Linn County and Senior Citizens of Sweet Home, Inc. dba Linn Shuttle.
