Resolution & Order 2024-416 – IGA with the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Wildlife Services

This is a Resolution and Order to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Wildlife Services (USDA APHIS-WS) and delegate authority to Wayne Mink. This agreement will allow APHIS-WS to provide professional wildlife management assistance to reduce or manage damage or conflicts caused by birds and/or other nuisance wildlife. This agreement is not to exceed \$12,500.
