ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB:

- Assists victims of crime within guidelines established by the District Attorney's Office. Work includes providing timely, knowledgeable, and supportive services to victims of crime.
- Initiate contact with victims, either by phone or in person. Explain services available, including an explanation of the criminal justice process, case information, referral services, crisis intervention, victim advocacy, and court accompaniment services, as appropriate.
- Coordinate efforts and share information with Deputy District Attorneys as well as with other Crime Victim Specialists, Legal Assistants and volunteers, in order to deliver justice and achieve the best possible outcomes for victims of crime.
- Foster effective working relationships with coworkers, law enforcement, other professionals, civic groups, court staff and the general public.
- Educate individuals and agencies regarding crime victim needs and rights.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree in Sociology, Psychology, Criminal Justice or related field required; and/or any satisfactory equivalent combination of experience, education and training in the criminal justice system, social work or crisis intervention, that demonstrates the ability to perform the job.
- Must be a person of the highest integrity.
- Must pass a criminal history background check, which includes fingerprinting.
- Must be able to work with and respond appropriately to highly agitated and threatening people.
- Ability to manage and maintain sensitive and confidential information.
- Maintain regular and predictable work attendance.
- Bilingual Spanish/English candidates encouraged to apply.
