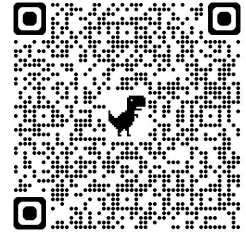

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST 1 – Food Program
Environmental Health Program (Classification 702)
SEIU Represented Full Time Position (37.5 hours/week)

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

This is a full-time position with the Environmental Health Program. Primary responsibilities will include inspection of restaurants, commissaries, vending machines, mobile food units and temporary restaurants to assure compliance with laws and rules. Responsibilities may also include communicable disease control, community outreach and education, consultation with individuals, groups and organizations, and investigation and enforcement of environmental complaints and regulations. A successful applicant will have knowledge of the principles and practices of environmental health; knowledge of the laws and administrative rules governing the environmental health programs of the State; ability to make thorough investigations, compile data, and present clear, concise reports; ability to promote awareness of, and participation toward the correction of public health problems among the general public; ability to plan and organize work effectively; knowledge of the methods and equipment used by the industries and any other phase of the social structure in which the program is concerned. A successful applicant will also develop and maintain effective, harmonious and reasonable work relationships with others, and will maintain regular and predictable work attendance.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

A Bachelor's degree in life or physical sciences, Environmental/Public Health or related field, or equivalent experience and training as determined by the Environmental Health Registration Board. Two years' experience in environmental health work. This position will be a Registered Environmental Health Specialist Trainee in the State of Oregon and a valid Oregon driver's license is required.
