ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

A Wrap Coach is working with youth and their family having intensive mental health needs. A Wrap Coach is responsible for coaching Wrap Care Coordinators on the ten Wraparound principles, four phases or Wraparound, and the activities/facilitation components associated with each phase of Wraparound. Wrap Coach develops coaching plans, observes and facilitates meetings, provides group and individual coaching. Experience with outreach, communication, and individualized service plan development. Work under QMHP supervision. Travel between work sites will be necessary. Must be willing to work as a part of an interdisciplinary team and follow documentation requirements in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rules and department policy and procedures. Wrap Coaches need two years of Wrap Care Coordination experience to be a Wrap Coach.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

QMHA Certification requires a bachelor's degree with major coursework in psychology, social work, counseling or related behavior science and 1,000 hours of clinical experience (6 months of full-time work in a state approved program); or 4 years progressive experience in mental health client service program; or satisfactory combination training and experience (4,000 hours of clinical experience, approximately 2 years of full-time work at a state approved program). Certified in Wrap Facilitation through Portland State University or Vroon is preferred. Required valid OR Driver's license and ability to pass a Criminal History check. Bilingual Spanish skills preferred. In addition, complete approved Wraparound coaches and supervisors training within 90 days of hire.
