- Operate Herbicide Application Vehicle
- Control Vegetation Using Chemical, Mechanical, and Manual Means
- Use Computer & Associated Office Equipment & Computer Controlled Spray Unit
- Prepare Reports, Maintain Records of Herbicide Meeting Federal & State Regulations
- Coordinate with Division Supervisors for Herbicide Application
- Monitor Treated Areas for Quality Control
- Load, Handle, & Mix Chemicals & Other Materials
- Apply anti-icing agent to roadways.
- Other duties as assigned
