| 1 | Question: Why is the County not designing this project? County Response: The City of Millersburg was awarded federal funds for this project. The City |
| | is not certified with the Oregon Department of Transportation to administer federally funded projects. Linn County is certified to administer federally funded projects, so the City requested that the County administer this project on their behalf. Due to scheduling and staffing, the County has elected to hire a consultant to design this project. |
| 2 | Question: Could the Agency please clarify if Evaluation Criteria #3 is referring to a percentage of time that staff will devote to the project or looking for hours staff will spend on project? |
| | County Response: The RFP criteria indicates "proportion of time". |
| 3 | Question: Will Linn County be performing the roadway design, temporary traffic control, and traffic handling? |
| | County Response: Table 13 of the RFP indicates the plan sheets to be prepared by the consultant. |
| | Question: Will a cover page, cover letter, and table of content count towards the page limit? |
| 4 | County Response: Please see Section 2.4.2 and Section 2.4.4 of the RFP. |
| 5 | Question: The RFP does not comply with Oregon Qualifications Based Selection (QBS) law for procurement of design professionals. Here is the issue: 1) The RFP is asking for pricing information (number of staff hours) from all proposers. What about this evaluation criteria 3? |
| | County Response: The 5 criteria listed for this RFP do not include any items that request the number of staffing hours. Criteria 3 is referring to the proportion of each staff's time spent. |
| | Request: Request for edits to contract terms and conditions. |
| 6 | County Response: The Contract language will be negotiated with the firm that is selected. |
