Dear Linn County Road Department:

We have received your application for a bridge replacement in Owl Creek, Township 12S, Range 04W, Section 17 SE/NW, Linn County, Oregon. Under the Oregon Removal-Fill Law (ORS 196.800 - 196.990), removal, filling, or alteration of 50 cubic yards or more of material within the bed or banks of the waters of this state, or any amount within waters designated Essential Salmonid Habitat or State Scenic Waterway, requires a permit from the Department of State Lands. Waters of this state include the Pacific Ocean, rivers, lakes, most ponds and wetlands, and other natural water bodies.

Based on the information provided in your application, it appears that your project does not require a State removal-fill permit because it involves less than 50 cubic yards of removal and/or fill in waters of this state that are not designated as Essential Salmonid Habitat or a State Scenic Waterway.

Please be aware that your project, while exempt from the State Removal-Fill requirements, may be subject to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers regulatory program and/or local planning department permitting process.

Additionally, approval of a fish passage plan from the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) is required. Contact your local ODFW office for more information.
